Injured Workers

Where workers have identified an injury or condition that is impacted by their work environment, we can investigate potential contributing factors in more detail. In addition to an assessment of the physical setup of the workstation, we also consider workflow, rest breaks, task allocation, and environmental factors. Although these broader factors are reviewed during all routine assessments, where an injury or condition is reported we may be required to spend additional time investigating their significance.

For this reason, it is reasonable to expect that in these circumstances an assessment may take additional time and include broader recommendations. Where requested or required, these can be documented in a formal report.

Scheduling

Routine individual workstation assessments usually require 30 minutes each (e.g. straightforward assessments for new staff members). More complex workstation assessments can require additional time, so scheduling should be adjusted accordingly.
