Annual Influenza Vaccination Programs

In 2024 Australia had the worst flu season on record with over 352,000 laboratory-confirmed cases, eclipsing the previous high of 313,615 cases in 2019. In contrast, there were about 540,000 less vaccinations given in 2024 than in 2023. This serves as a reminder to take proactive measures and get your flu vaccinations in early during 2025.

Protect Your Team From The Flu

Flu related illness also translates to a huge cost for business – Absenteeism currently costs the Australian economy about \$7 billion, while the cost of presenteeism (where employees are sick on the job) is approximately \$34 billion through lost productivity.

Qualified Nurses Will Administer Vaccines Onsite at Your Adelaide Metro Workplace

Our qualified nursing team will travel to your workplace and undertake the necessary pre-screening and administration of the vaccine. CHG's nurses are fully qualified Registered Nurses with immunisation training, CPR certificates and First Aid certificates.

We can also provide promotional material to promote participation in your onsite influenza vaccination program.

2025 Flu Vaccination Program

The CHG onsite flu vaccination program will commence in March 2025 and will continue until approximately the end of May.

The cost for onsite quadrivalent flu vaccinations outside the metropolitan area within our standard hours is \$35+GST per person for 10 or more flu vaccines plus travel time to and from the location charged at \$65+GST per hour and 66c per km.

Our nurse will arrive approximately 15 minutes prior to the scheduled appointment time to set up and undertake a short Risk Assessment on the environment in which they will be working.

If you indicate that a site induction is required, the nurse will arrive even earlier to accommodate this requirement.
